

All about this week	<p>This week we will continue reading Alien Hotel or 5 a side Beach Battle</p>  	<p>This week we are going to be looking at mini-scripts and giving you a chance to write a small script for a TV programme or YouTube channel of your choice.</p>	<p>Check your emails for this week's spellings. This week we would like you to practise some of the learning you have done throughout your time in year 4. You will be adding, subtracting, multiplying, dividing and even some fraction work! Please complete a quick warm up before each session to make sure your muscles are warm and ready for the activity – we recommend one of the shorter Joe Wicks sessions on Youtube.</p>	<p>This week we are setting a TOP SECRET MISSION! This week is all about something things that you are interested in. The work you produce will be shared with your year 5 teacher.</p>
Monday	<p>Alien hotel</p>  <p>Read chapter 7 (final chapter) 5-a-side Read chapter 1 of 5-a-side Beach</p>	<p>Read the mini script. Look at how it is laid out. What do you notice about the use of ()?</p>	 <p>Put your spellings into sentences.</p>	<p>Jumping Today we would like you to practise multiplying and dividing whilst increasing your stamina for jumping. For this session you will need:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A stopwatch, clock or timer (to record how long you are jumping for) • A pen/pencil and your work book. 	<p>Today you need to decide what you would like to do your top secret mission on. It can be something you do outside of school, something you enjoy or something you are really interested in, but DO NOT tell your grown-ups! We would like you to spend today researching your chosen topic (in secret) without your parents help. They will get to find out about it at the end of the week!</p>

	<p>Battle</p> 			<p>To start we would like you to check you know how to start or set your timer for 1 minute. Once you are happy with that the jumping can start. Jump, whether its straight up and down landing on two feet, or bouncing on a trampoline or star jumps, for 1 minute. You need to count each jump in your head for that minute. Record your score.</p> <p>We would now like you to multiply your score to find out how many jumps you could've done for:</p> <p>5 minutes 10 minutes 20 minutes 50 minutes 100 minutes</p> <p>To challenge yourself find out how many jumps you could've done in 72 minutes. A 2do has been set for you to type in your answers.</p>

Keep going until you think you have thrown the longest distance in the year group. Send your scores and a picture of your column addition to your teacher. Remember this is a mini script so it won't be a whole episode.

You can use the story board outline provided on Purple Mash or do this in your workbook.

- **Pencil and work book**

Start by deciding where you are going to run and how many times you will run round it. For example, if you are running around a field you may only want to run it once but if you are in your garden you may decide to do 10 laps. We would then like you to estimate how long the run is in metres (this is only an estimate, don't worry if you don't know exactly just make an estimate, to help, you will be about 1.25m in height). You will then need to run your chosen length and have someone time you. Once you know how long it took for you to run the whole length we would like you to calculate the following:

1. How long did it take for you to run half of the track?
2. How long did it take you to run a quarter of the track?
3. How long did it take you to run an eighth of the track?
4. How long did it take you to run a tenth of the track?
5. How long did it take you to run three quarters of the track?
